BACKGROUND

In Pakistan, particularly in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP), the need for social protection measures is paramount due to various socio-economic challenges. The region faces issues such as poverty, unemployment, natural disasters, and displacement, which significantly impact vulnerable populations. Social protection measures are crucial to providing a safety net for these individuals, ensuring they have access to basic services, healthcare, education, and livelihood opportunities. Additionally, in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, the need for social protection has become even more urgent to support those affected by the economic downturn and health crisis. Implementing effective social protection measures in KP is essential to alleviate poverty, reduce inequality, and promote inclusive development. There is a significant gap between the people and the awareness regarding already implemented social protection measures by the government in Pakistan, especially in KP. Many individuals, particularly those in rural and marginalized communities, are unaware of the various social protection programs available to them. This lack of awareness results in underutilization of these programs and leaves vulnerable populations without the support they desperately Additionally, there is often a lack of transparency and accessibility in the information provided about these programs, further exacerbating the gap. Bridging this gap requires targeted awareness campaigns, improved communication channels, and enhanced community engagement to ensure that all eligible individuals are able to access the social protection measures they are entitled to. The Implementation Support Unit of the Directorate of Elementary and Secondary Education, KP (ISU-DoE&SE), with the technical and financial assistance of UNICEF, conducted a comprehensive awareness campaign on key social welfare programs including the Ehsaas Program, Benazir Income Support, Sehat Card, Bait-ul-Maal and Emergency Service Department. The campaign, held in District Peshawar, Mansehra and Kohat, targeted teachers, Parent Teacher Council (PTC) members, students, and community stakeholders. Its objective was to educate them about these critical programs and their associated benefits, promoting greater access and participation within the community.

AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

The awareness campaign encompassed targeted sessions with PTC members of various schools across Peshawar, Mansehra and Kohat, to educate them about the government's social protection measures which are as follows:

EHSAAS PROGRAM

The Ehsaas Program focuses on poverty alleviation, social protection, and financial inclusion. It provides various services and benefits to eligible individuals and families to improve their livelihoods.

BENAZIR INCOME SUPPORT PROGRAM (BISP)

BISP aims to support low-income families by providing financial assistance and other benefits. It targets vulnerable populations and offers enrollment based on specific eligibility criteria.

SEHAT CARD PROGRAM

The Sehat Card scheme offers health insurance coverage to disadvantaged communities, ensuring access to essential medical treatments and procedures. Eligible individuals receive a Sehat Card to avail themselves of healthcare services.

EMERGENCY SERVICE DEPARTMENT

The Emergency Service Department provides emergency medical assistance, ambulance services, and disaster response to ensure timely support during critical situations.

BAIT-UL-MAAL

Bait-ul-Maal is a governmental organization in Pakistan dedicated to providing financial assistance and social welfare services to the underprivileged. It aims to uplift marginalized communities through various initiatives, including financial aid, healthcare support, and vocational training, ultimately striving for a more equitable society.

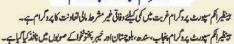

RESULTS

The campaign encompassed conducting awareness sessions in 237 schools across District Peshawar and Kohat, educating a total of 1,425 (689 Female and 736 Male) PTC members about the programs. These sessions were organized in close collaboration with school administrations, PTC members, and community leaders. Various dissemination methods, including the distribution of banners and community meetings, were employed to effectively convey information about the social welfare programs.

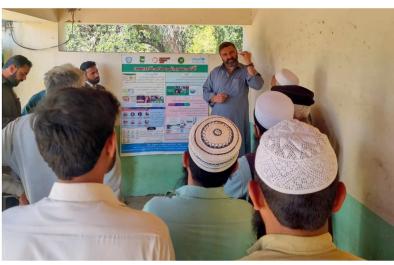
















IMPACT OF THE CAMPAIGN
